New Business

Julie Sasaki:

- Julie began the meeting with prayer.
- The December minutes were approved.
- At our February meeting we will discuss the current state of the PTG budget. So far it looks like we are on the right track with regard to income and expenses.
- We will also discuss in February the parent education component of PTG. We will vote on whether to continue promoting parent education nights, how much money we are willing to allocate towards parent education, and if we want parent education to be part of the PTG mission.

- The WASC report has been finished and sent to the printer. The visiting committee will come for a pre-visit the week of January 19th. Highlights of the Action Plan include focusing on the vertical integration of curriculum across the diocese and focus on religion curriculum.
