And I accept the director's decisions concerning casting.

I understand if my child is disruptive or disrespectful, the instructor may excuse him/her short-term or permanently with written or verbal notification. I understand this is a Monday through Friday, 1 week summer drama camp, with a tech rehearsal (Friday 4:00pm–6:00pm Tech Rehearsal at Danville Village Theatre followed by dinner backstage) and performance (7pm Curtain) at Danville Village Theatre on Friday, July 6th for Camp A and Friday, July 27 for Camp B). I will make every attempt to have my child attend all practices. If I know my child will not be at a rehearsal, I will contact the instructor in advance by phone or by email.

The Tuition/Registration fee is Non-Refundable. The Registration Fee covers Licensing and Royalties of the Broadway Junior musical, 1 Script, 1 Rehearsal CD, theater rental deposit, production essentials, sets, props, supplies and FULL costumes. Once the Registration Form, Fee and Tuition are received, a Welcome email (sent out one week prior to camp start date) containing our rehearsal calendar and day by day lesson plans will be included, also general information about the camp and finally a Classroom Policies/Participation Agreement will also be included

## Camp A: “Disney’s Cinderella, Kids.”



### What is Musical Theater?
